The undersigned agree to the following terms:

- a. The routine will be at the Intermediate/Silver syllabus level or higher. Exceptions to this rule must be approved in advance by the Program Chairperson and Committee.
- b. The routine will be no longer than 2 1/2 minutes (3-4 minutes Pro/Pro). A non-repetitive sequence of patterns is encouraged.
- c. The participants will wear appropriate costumes for the dance being performed.
- d. The participants will provide their own music. Music medium will be on CD unless otherwise coordinated with the DJ providing the music the exhibition is to be performed.

e. The preferred night for the performance is (circle one):

- f. The Program Committee will endeavor to schedule the exhibition on the night desired. However the Committee reserves the right to determine both the performance date and time to ensure a good mix of the types of dances and levels of exhibitions to be performed. The committee will inform the participants of any schedule changes with as much lead-time as possible.
- g. Participants agree that they will be no remuneration for the exhibition performed and agree to the use of their names in the official dance brochure/program.
- h. Pro/Pro Exhibitions will be paid according to written agreement with the Program Chairperson in advance of the exhibition. **A professional is defined as an individual who derives at least 50% of his/her income from teaching dancing.**
- i. Performers (except dance professionals) will be responsible for paying the posted admission fee to the event during which they will perform.  
Dinner Dance exhibitions will all be performed following dinner. Performers may choose to pay for and attend the dinner OR pay the walk-in admission price if they come after the dinner period.
- j. The **DEADLINE** for submission of this request (including bio) is **December 15<sup>th</sup>, 2008.** CANCELLATIONS need to be coordinated with the Program Chairperson, Wanda Smith, by December 26<sup>th</sup> 2008, to allow for required program changes.
- k. Exhibition Programs will be posted at the information support desk. It will be the responsibility of each performer to verify the date, time, and information (name, studio, bio, etc) by 2:00PM each day to allow for any changes before printing the Programs.
